Seniors must exhibit all three of these criteria to be considered for the awards.

The scholarship is a non-renewable gift, awarded to the student before he or she matriculates into their first year of any accredited college or university. The scholarship awards are contingent upon the Western School of Technology and Environmental Science PTSA Scholarship Committee receiving official verification of the student’s acceptance and matriculation at his or her college or university. The scholarship recipients will be recognized at the Awards Ceremonies of the Western School of Technology and Environmental Science on May 23, 2019.



## **The Western School of Technology and Environmental Science PTSA Annual Scholarship 2019 Application Instructions**

Applicants must meet the following criteria:

1. Must be a graduating senior from Western School of Technology and Environmental Science who has been accepted into an accredited college or university.
2. Must have a cumulative high school grade point average of B (3.0 on 4.0 scale) or above.
3. Must have a record of extra-curricular activities which reflect a well-rounded, community-minded student (e.g. clubs, student government, mentoring, community service, etc.).
4. The student or a parent or guardian must be a current member of the Western Tech PTSA.

Applicants must submit the following documents and materials in a single complete packet:

1. A complete and signed **Application Form**
2. A certified copy of the applicant's **High School Transcript**
3. A copy of your **College or University Acceptance Letter**
4. A **Letter of Recommendation** on the provided form from a Teacher, Counselor, Administrator  
Community or Organization Leader, Supervisor or Employer
5. An **Essay** (250 words) addressing the topic(s) listed below.
  - a. Format essay in Microsoft Word, Times New Roman 12-point font, double spaced, as a hardcopy or on thumb drive.
  - b. Essay Header to include: Full name, Name of school, Title of Essay.
  - c. Essay must be signed by both the applicant and their parent or legal guardian.

**Your essay can answer one or as many of the questions and topics below that apply to your accomplishments and leadership, background and influences, and/or future plans and goals.**

Describe any special attributes or accomplishments that set you apart. How you have demonstrated leadership ability either in or out of school? Write about an experience from your own life and explain how it has influenced your development. Tell us who in your life has been your biggest influence and why. How has your family background affected the way you see the world? How has your education or Western Tech experience contributed to who you are today? What are your plans for the future and goals?
