## Reassessment Parameters

- Not all assignments are eligible for reassessment; the teacher designates which assignments are eligible based on the content standards of the course
- All students should have opportunities to demonstrate greater understanding, regardless of the grade on the original assessment, if they meet the following requirements: complete the original assessment, complete required assignments, and complete reteaching/relearning activities as determined by the teacher
- Reassessment opportunities may occur partially, entirely, or in a different format as determined by the teacher
- Students' grades should reflect all new learning. Only the higher scores should be included in the students' marking period grade
- Students will be provided a minimum of one and maximum of two reassessment opportunities prior to the printing of interim reports

*and*

a minimum of one and maximum of two reassessment opportunities after the printing of interim reports and before the closing of grades for the marking period

- The end-of-unit summative assessment can be administered only once, and thus students cannot retake the same assessment to improve their score
