Students learn medical terminology, core health science foundations, and necessary healthcare delivery skills. As juniors, students are provided an opportunity to complete an internship in multiple medical facilities and assist with hands-on patient care.
Automotive Service Technology <i>Mr. Cunningham</i> <i>scunningham3@bcps.org</i>	Automotive Service Technology is a state of the art and nationally certified program which provides students with hours of hands-on training to successfully complete 223 tasks in four areas of Automotive Repair, as outlined by Automotive Service Excellence (ASE).
