Students are expected to continue to follow Western Tech's CPR2 while engaging with online learning. Please follow these additional guidelines to meet with success in your virtual classrooms

- Before you begin, be sure that you are logged into to your BCPS Google Account.
- When you enter the Google Meet, remember that you are entering our classroom and that general classroom etiquette applies.
Teachers may be recording the lesson for students to view later.
- All comments (typed or spoken) and gestures should be school appropriate, respectful, and meaningful, and relevant to the topic.
- Reduce distractions.
 - Mute your microphone if you are not speaking.
 - Try to stay in one place, and if you need to move or step away for a minute, turn off your video.
 - Do your best to stay focused on the lesson and not on your surroundings. If you need to step away, do so.
- Your teachers have been working hard to make these meeting spaces available to you and your classmates, so please be kind to them and to each other.
- All participants must continue to follow the BCPS Telecommunications Policy. Students who choose not to follow the telecommunications policy or the Virtual Class Code of Conduct will not be allowed to continue with the session.
