Good Afternoon Rising Seniors and Family Members:

We hope you are doing well. Although we don't know what to fully expect for the upcoming college application process, we are dedicated to making sure that you are ready for college and career. In order to best support you, we are offering the Wolverine SAT Summer Institute for all rising seniors. The purpose of the institute is to afford seniors the opportunity to refine skills, complete practice exams, get support from teachers, and participate in college and career planning.

Beginning July 20<sup>th</sup>, you will have access to the Wolverine SAT Summer Institute course on Schoology. You will find folders with English and Math resources, as well as recorded mini-lessons and tips from your teachers.

The following week, live Google Meets sessions will begin and will run through August 28<sup>th</sup>. During the Google Meets sessions you can ask questions, work on important strategies, complete practice SAT problems, and receive guidance on the college application process and career planning. A schedule of sessions will be posted on our Wolverine SAT Summer Institute Schoology page.

The first administration of the SAT for the 2020-2021 school year is August 29<sup>th</sup>. The registration deadline for the August SAT administration is July 31<sup>st</sup>. Additional testing dates are scheduled for September, October, November, and December. Please keep in mind that there is a registration fee for each of the fall administrations unless the student is eligible for an exam fee reduction or waiver (please see the letter attached to this email and return). The exam fee reduction/waiver letter should be signed, scanned, and sent to Ms. Tavernia at [atavernia@bcps.org](mailto:atavernia@bcps.org). You may also call the school to arrange a date and time to drop off the signed letter if that is more convenient. At this time, a decision regarding the administration of an SAT Day for rising BCPS seniors in the Fall (i.e., the SAT administered for free at the school) has not been made.
