



Western Tech Robotics Club Members Participate in Windsor Mill Middle School's 2017 Family STEM Night

On Thursday, March 23, 2017, members of Western Tech's Robotics Club participated in the 2017 Windsor Mill Middle School Family STEM Night. Each year Windsor Mill host a STEM Night as part of their Science Fair Competition and Celebration. They have a variety of Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics displays throughout the school. This year, several student organizations demonstrated their Robotics expertise—The First Robotics Community Club from Carroll County, Car Racing Club from UMBC, Drone Club from Windsor Mill, and the Western Tech Robotics Club.
