## Update-Western Tech Reassessment Parameters 2021-2022

2<sup>nd</sup>-4<sup>th</sup> Quarter

• Students will be provided a **minimum of one reassessment** opportunity prior to interim reports

and

a <u>minimum of one reassessment</u> opportunity after interim reports and before the closing of grades for the marking period.

• All students will have opportunities to demonstrate greater understanding, regardless of the grade earned on the original assignment.

To be eligible for reassessments, students must:

- o Complete the original assessment by the deadline.
- o Complete reteaching/relearning activities as determined by the teacher.
- Not all assignments are eligible for reassessment; the teacher designates which
  assignments are eligible based on the content standards of the course. In accordance
  with Rule 5120: Enrollment and Attendance, teachers are not required to provide
  make-up work to students absent for unlawful reasons.
- Students are expected to review timely feedback and course materials prior to completing a reassessment. Students are also encouraged to participate in coach class and review opportunities as available.
- Reassessment opportunities may occur partially, entirely, or in a different format as
  determined by the teacher. Only the higher scores will be included in the students'
  marking period grade.
- Summative unit assessments cannot be retaken or redone. This includes end-of-unit and end-of-semester/marking period assessments in all courses.

*Note:* The student's grade is determined by a body of evidence.
