Internships

Articulation with CCBC

All students are offered the opportunity to qualify for as many as six college credits through our articulation with the Community College of Baltimore County. Certifications

The Graphic/Print Communications Technology program at Western was the first in Baltimore County to offer Nationally certified PrintED® competencies training. Students completing the program will gain certification in PrintED. Students will also gain industry certification as Adobe Certified Professionals in ACP Photoshop and ACP Illustrator. Students will earn a new specialty credential, Adobe Certified Professional in Visual Design by passing the ACP certification in both Photoshop and Illustrator. Students also have opportunities to gain additional industry certifications and specialty credentials.

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
